Care Coordination Toolkit

OneCare developed a care coordination toolkit to support the community-based care coordination efforts occurring in health service areas. The toolkit is designed to be a resource for coordinating care for those patients with complex needs. The toolkit also serves as a resource for existing case management programs to integrate best practices. The toolkit is reviewed quarterly to ensure that the tools and best practices are up to date.

Care coordination is centered on individuals and their families, encourages shared decision-making by way of intentional processes that actively engage each individual in creating a shared plan of care. Effective care coordination requires timely identification of individuals who could benefit from coordinated service delivery and transitions of care, and engaging them in a systematic approach to care coordination in the context of strong community-based linkages among clinical and non-clinical services.
